Project objectives

- to elaborate common understanding between CSOs (WG3 of EaP CSF National platforms) and agree on terminology within “Good Environmental Governance” concept and the concept by itself

- to define and advocate CSOs positions for preparation and adoption of regional and national targets to be included into the Declaration’s Action plan/ National plans

- to start tripartite dialogues as suggested by the 4.1. paragraph of the Declaration on topic “How to achieve Good environmental Governance”, using prepared Position papers (see objective 2 above)

- CSOs – members of the EaP CSF National platforms, in particular of WG3 is the main target group

- Ministries of Environment (MoE) and/ or Agencies with similar function of 3 respectful countries

- Governments of 3 countries, Business associations, Chambers of commerce also to be addressed

4

- EUD in countries and EaP Panel on Environment and Climate Change will be addressed as well

Project Outcomes and Activities



1. The common understanding on what a Good Environmental Governance concept is and its terminology is advanced and sustained (5 activities)

2. Positions of EaP CSF Nat Platforms WG3 in three countries are defined and prepared in written (as living document) and communicated to target groups thus becomes widely known and influencing opinions of actors in the environmental field and beyond (7 activities)

3. Simultaneous discussion between EUD, MoE and CSOs during tripartite meeting on the topic of “How to achieve Good environmental Governance” using prepared by project Position papers contributed to better mutual understanding and trust, convergence of positions and development of continuous tripartite dialogue (6 activities)

4. The project will mainstream gender equality into the project's core
