

# EaP CSF COVID Re-granting Scheme Overview of funded projects

### **Moldova**

## MD\_01: Every child matters

Partner organisation: Foundation for Advancement of Moldova Implementation period: 01 December 2020 – 28 February 2021

Facilitating the access of vulnerable children from migrant and Roma families to online classes through the purchasing of 80 iPads/tablets with remote internet access, while providing training on cybersecurity and safe internet use. Purchasing PPE to allow children to attend offline classes where possible.

# MD\_02: Strengthen the capacity of Moldovan non-profit

Partner organisation: Centre for Home Social and Medical Assistance "CASMED"

Implementation period: 27 November 2020 – 15 February 2021

Purchasing PPE for CASMED volunteers and staff to allow them to continue providing direct care to beneficiaries. Equipping a multi-media room to facilitate online training sessions and other meetings. Proving 70 CASMED staff and volunteers with training on infection prevention and control practices, and crisis communication and management.

### MD\_03: Sustainable adaptation for INoVa(EN)tive impact

Partner organisation: INVENTO Non-governmental organization Implementation period: 01 December 2020 – 28 February 2021

Purchasing laptops for 2 members of the INVENTO personnel, complete with software for internal purposes (Cloud Storage, Mobile scanner, G Suite, Asana/Basecamp, Microsoft Office, 1C) and engagement with beneficiaries (WebEx, Zoom). Development of a tailored online service delivery platform, as well as an adapted strategic plan for the next 2 years.

# MD\_04: Adapt the NGO Vesta activities to work more safety and effectively in a pandemic

Partner organisation: NGO "Regional Association of Women with Large Families - VESTA"

Implementation period: 01 December 2020 – 28 February 2021

Purchasing PPE for use by VESTA personnel, and installing 2 bactericidal lamps in the organisation's office. Equipping the office with 1 new filing cabinet and a licence for the Zoom videoconferencing software. Providing online and/or offline training on online



communications, conducting online surveys, and conducting online events for partner organisations and police, social services, local authority, medical, and other personnel. Support VESTA employees during this stressful period by facilitating individual consultations with a psychologist.
