Legal framework

- ❖ The Framework Agreement between the Republic of Moldova and the European Union on the Republic of Moldova's Participation in EU Crisis Management Operations, ratified by National Law No.75 as of 12 April 2013, entered into force on 01 July 2013.
- ❖ National Action Plan for the Implementation of the Moldova - EU Association Agreement for 2017-2019 approved by the Government Decision no.1472 as of December 30, 2016.
- ❖ EU Council Decision 2013/34 / CFSP of 17 January 2013 on a military training mission and counseling to the defense and security forces in Mali.

Ukrainian Contribution to EU-led Military Operations and Police Missions



- EUPM in the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (2004 – 2006) - 5 policemen
- EUPM in Bosnia and Herzegovina (2004 – 2005) - 5 policemen
- EU NAVFOR ATALANTA (2010 – 2014) - 249 servicemen





Contribution of Armed Forces of Ukraine to EU NAVFOR ATALANTA



2010 – Ukraine joined operation and send one officer to Operation Staff

2014 – Ukraine sent frigate "Getman Sahaidachny" with crew, special forces unit , deck helicopter Ka-27 PR.

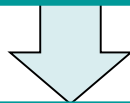




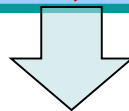
Perspectives of EU-UKR Military Cooperation in the Framework of CSDP



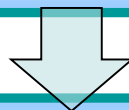
