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

### Legal framework

♦The Framework Agreement between the Republic of Moldova and the European Union on the Republic of Moldova's Participation in EU Crisis Management Operations, ratified by National Law No.75 as of 12 April 2013, entered into force on 01 July 2013.

♦National Action Plan for the Implementation of the Moldova - EU Association Agreement for 2017-2019 approved by the Government Decision no.1472 as of December 30, 2016.

♦ EU Council Decision 2013/34 / CFSP of 17 January 2013 on a military training mission and counseling to the defense and security forces in Mali.

- EU NAVFOR ATALANTA (2010 2014) 249 servicemen










