Structured Consultation**

Ideas: Combatting corruption through capacity building

- Developing **exchange, peer-to-peer and job shadowing** schemes for EaP and EU law enforcement professionals
- Supporting **specialised parliamentary committees** with trainings on anti-corruption
- Improving interaction between state institutions and **'watchdogs'**.
- Establishing an EaP **Anti-Corruption Academy** for **'anti-corruption ambassadors'**

Ideas: Focusing more on local and regional levels

- *Increasing **conditionality and performance-based** funding allocation, which would take into account progress towards decentralisation and of rule of law on the **subnational level**.*
- *Demonstrating a **zero tolerance policy** by acting fast and efficiently with regards to breaches of the rule of law.*

Ideas: Strengthening accountability mechanisms and exchange with EU member states

- Strengthening the **bilateral cooperation and interoperability** of EU and EaP countries anti-corruption bodies, including data exchange.
- Applying more target pressure for the adoption and implementation of **core accountability mechanisms** for public officials.
- Introducing a monitoring mechanism for rule of law similar to the existing **EU justice scoreboard** applied to the EU Member States.
