- 1. Overall description of project implementation, changes in timeline and reasons for change

The overall aim of the project was to develop capacities of organizations of National Platforms in four countries (Armenia, Belarus, Georgia and Ukraine) in gender audit and gender analysing. Through intensive trainings organizational develop their skills in gender mainstreaming, namely gender audit, analyses, budgeting and monitoring. The project also contributed to the development of experts in gender auditing four









Subgroups within National Platforms of four countries, as well as to the establishment of Regional Gender Network in the EaP countries. The project gave us an opportunity to strengthen and enlarge Gender Subgroups and gender agenda in not only respective National Platforms of the countries involved in the project- Armenia, Georgia, Ukraine and Belarus, but also in Azerbaijan and Moldova (countries that were not part of the project). countries. The project greatly contributed to the development/strengthening of Gender. Cooperation between gender subgroups of six countries were established, which was not planned in the initial proposal.

There were no crucial changes in the timeline, but we asked to prolong the project for one month, because work on the joint module on Gender Auditing took more time than we have expected.

Training evaluation results: 11 people evaluated knowledge and theoretical concepts received during this training as very useful, more 3 as useful. 9 people evaluated received practical skills as very useful, 4 people as useful. Topics that participants mentioned as the most interesting are: 1) Goals of gender audit, 2) methods of data collection during audit, 3) practical work, 4) experience sharing, 5) an audit of the organizations. 12 people evaluated work of a trainer as great, 1 as good and 1 more person as average. All participants are very much satisfied with the program of the training. Majority (10 people) mentioned that their expectations were met, and they learnt what they thought I will. More 4 people answered that their expectations were even exceeded. All participants mentioned that they feel very so somewhat

3. Gender mainstreaming

The whole project was aimed at the mainstreaming of gender approach into the EaP National Platforms. As a result of our project gender subgroups were established in Georgia and Armenia (still haven't received formal confirmation from the Secretariat though) and strengthen in Ukraine and Belarus. Even though Modlova and Azerbaijan were not part of our project, but we also included them in our joint skype calls and conference, so Gender Network can be extended beyond the project. Gender audit as an instrument of gender mainstreaming is developed and can be used to measure and evaluate gender sensitivity of member organizations and the whole Platform as an institution.

6. Project Sustainability Outlook

Gender Subgroups (formal and informal) in four countries will continue their activities beyond the scope of the project. Beside, currently we are planning a conference of Regional Gender Network. Gender Subgroups are becoming more active in the National Platforms of EaP Civil Society Forum. In order to strengthen the work of Gender Subgroups a joint conference with the representatives from all six countries is becoming a necessity. The conference will help us to develop our strategies and future plans and discuss possibilities of development of Regional Gender Network in EaP countries.

Two projects in the framework of Regranting project of EaP have been already organized in the past two years that helped to foster cooperation between Gender Subgroups from selected countries, but we never had an opportunity to meet with the representatives of all 6 countries. Moreover, we will never had an opportunity to position ourselves as a Gender Network.

We plan to organize 2 days conference with the participation of 2 people from each country: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine.

Preliminary **topics** for discussion at the Conference:

- 1. Strategies to establish/strengthen Gender Subgroups
- 2. Opportunities and obstacles for development of Regional Gender Network of EaP countries
- 3. Gender audit of EaP strategies and polices
- 4. Lobbying of gender projects and polices within EaP National Platforms
- 5. Strategic planning for Regional Gender Network for upcoming 2-3 years
- 6. Communication and PR strategies for Gender Subgroups and Regional Network

The conference will also provide us visibility and stress the importance of gender component within National Platforms.

Currently, we are looking for funding for the Conference.
