- ▶ The WG meetings are the occasion to decide all the above together.



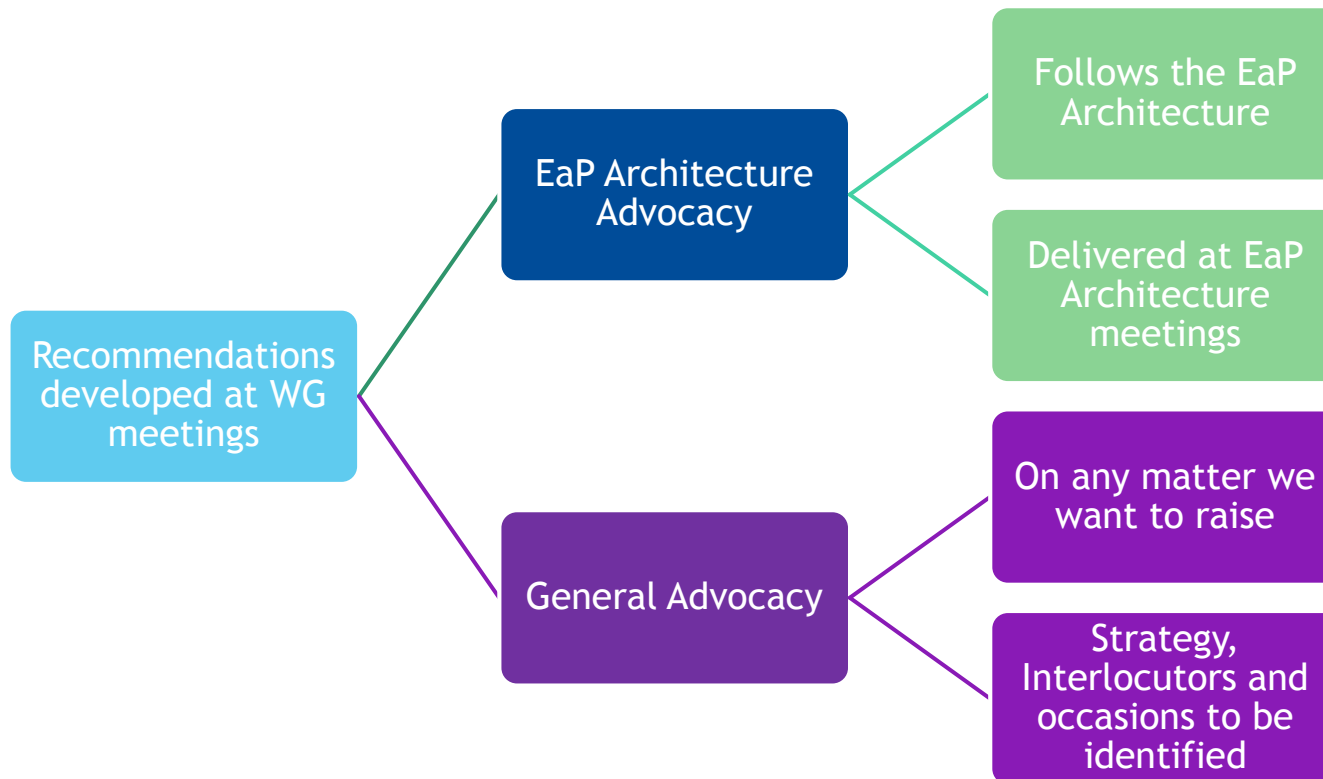

DEȘEURI BIODEGRADABILE (Fracția UMEDĂ)



Aruncă aici resturi alimentare: legume, fructe, produse de panificație, coji de ouă, alimente învechite, condimente, filtre de cafea și pliculețe de coai etc.

DEȘEURI RECICLABILE (Fracția USCĂ)



Aici aruncați toate deșeurile, în afară de deșeurile biodegradabile (alimentare și agricole) și sticla. O parte din aceste deșeuri vor merge la reciclare, iar o parte la valorificare energetică. Plasticul, hîrtia și metalul trebuie reciclate pentru că fiecare tonă de hîrtie reciclată poate salva 17 copaci, reciclînd o sticlă de plastic se economisește energie pentru funcționarea unui bec de 60W timp de 6 ore, iar aluminiul este 100% reciclabil.

Sticla este un material 100% reciclabil. Indiferent de culoare, formă și utilizare, pot fi reciclate orice recipiente din sticlă. E recomandabil ca sticla să fie spălată înainte de a fi aruncată la coș.

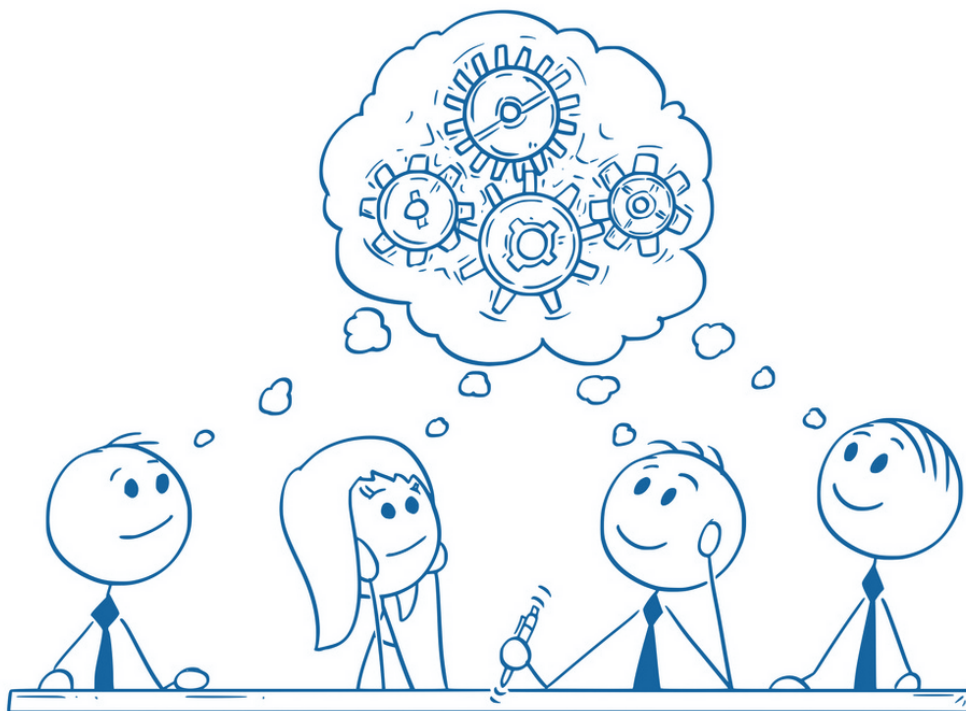
