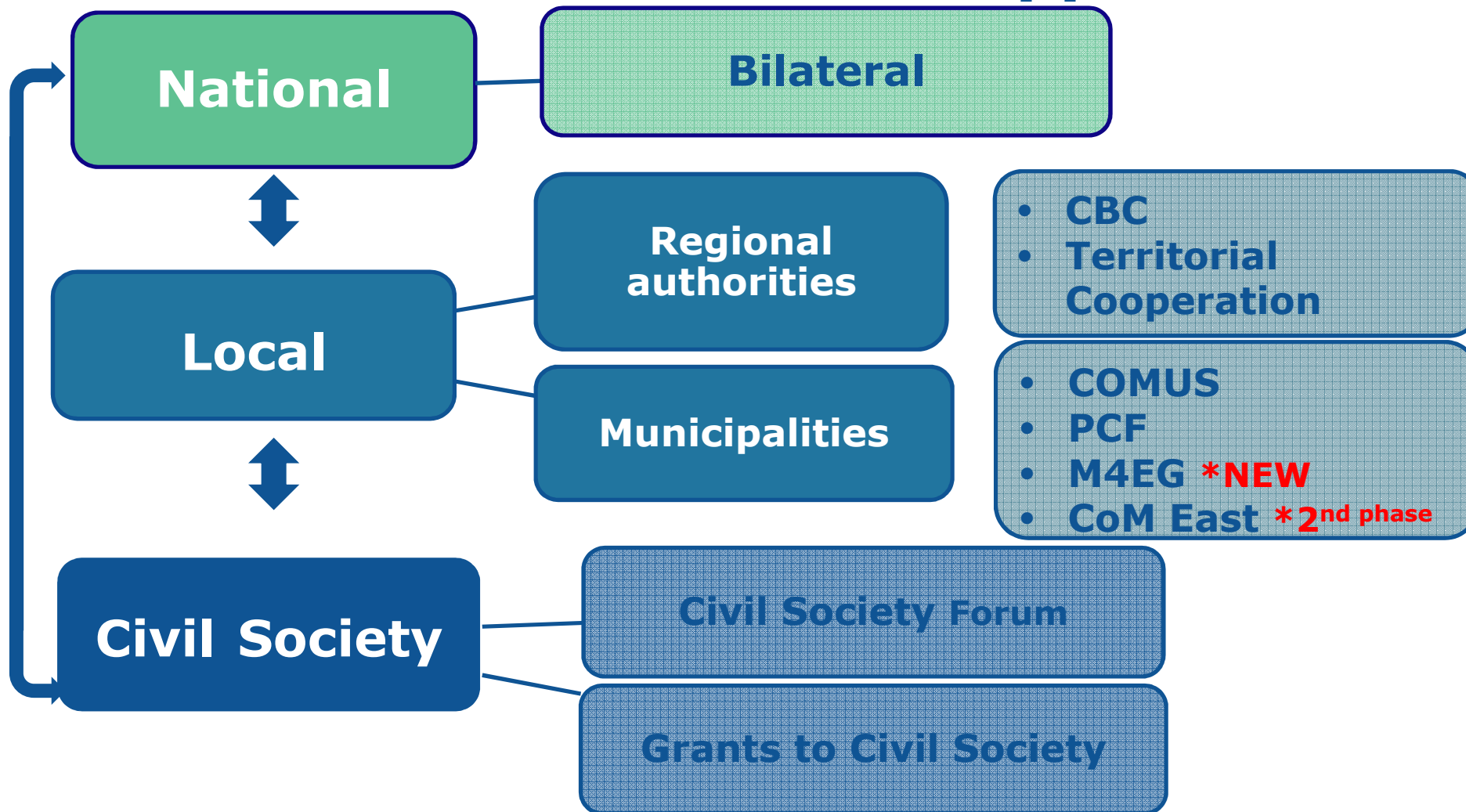

- New integrated CoM for Climate and Energy is launched at COP21

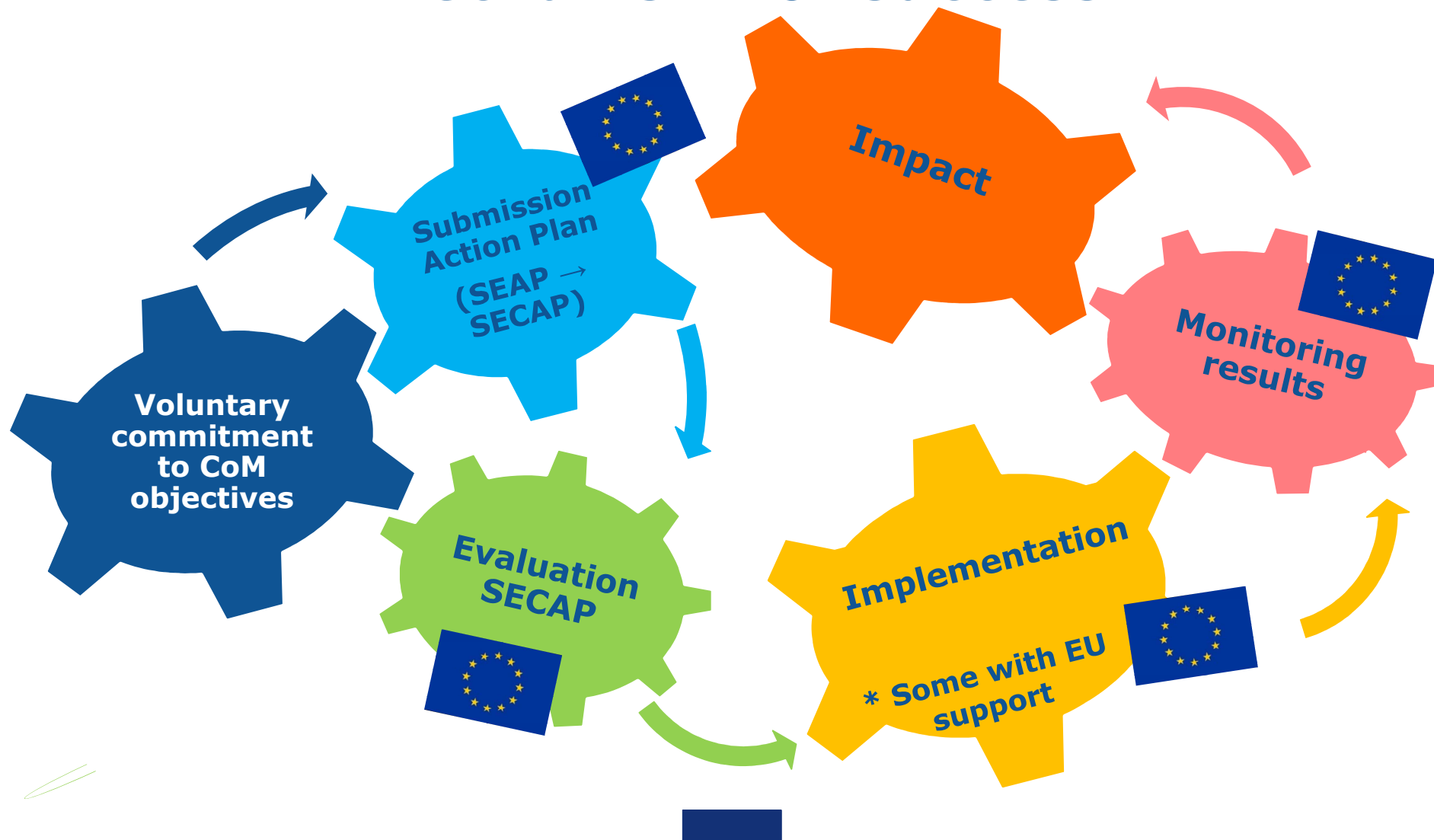
